2024 College Admission and Multicultural Family Admission

I Understanding College Admission

1. Standard College Admission System

- Since the 2015 college admission, 'Simplification Plan for College Admission' has been introduced that has standardized the college admission system focusing on the critical admission factors.
- OO-focused admission means an admission that applies OO, which is an admission factor, for more than 50%. For example, a plan with school record 60% + interview 40% is called the school record admission as the percentage of the application of the school record is more than 50%.
- Colleges and universities work on simplification of college admission within the standardized admission system.
- The early admission mainly includes school records(academic record, comprehensive record), essays, practical test/achievements while the regular admission includes the Scholastic Ability Test, practical test/achievements, etc.

2. Admission Category

a. School Record Admission

The school record admission, which evaluates students based on the school record as its main admission factor, falls into either of the two following categories.

- (1) Student Record : Assessment based on the grades of academic subjects, applying the school record according to the characteristics of the admission category.
- (2) Comprehensive record: Comprehensive assessment on the student based on the overall school records with admissions officers, etc. in participation

b. Essay Admission

The main factor of the essay admission is an essay, and its application percentage can be 100% or be partial along with the academic school record.

c. Practical test/achievement Admission

The practical test/achievement admission takes the practical test result as a main factor including the special talent admission, which is getting reduced upon the policy of the Ministry of Education.

d. Scholastic Aptitude Test(SAT) Admission

The SAT admission mainly reviews the grade of the SAT in the regular admission.

- a. The September mock test conducted by the Korea Institute for Curriculum and Evaluation is held on 2023. 9. 6.(Wed.) followed by the application for the early admission from 9. 11.(Mon.), which is 5 days after the test, till 9. 15.(Fri.), for 3 days in total for each college. The last application day for colleges is usually the last day of the period.
- b. The additional enrollment for unenrollment in both the early and the regular admissions is done for 7 days just like the previous year, while the additional admission period is a day shorter than the previous year, 9 days down to 8 days. The last announcement on the website will be made at 14:00, and 1:1 announcement till 18:00 in the 2023 admission.

4. Outline of 2024 College Admission

- a. The total number of recruitments decreased, the keynote identical to that in the previous year

(1) The total number of recruitments decreased compared to 2023 by 4,828, down to 344,296.

(2) The ratio of the early and the regular admissions slightly changed

- 272,032, which is 79.0% of the total number 344,296, are selected by the early admission.
- 72,264, which is 21.0% of the total number 344,296, are selected by the regular admission.
- The total number of the early admission decreased by 410, and increased by 1.0%p.
- The total number of the regular admission decreased by 4,418, and also by 1.0%p.

(3) Slight increase of the regular admission of colleges in the capital area

- The ratio of the regular admission in the capital area increased by 0.3%p, from 35.3% in 2023 to 35.6% in 2024, which is about 3 times higher than that in the local area, 11.9%.
- Of the total decrease in the number of applicants, the decrease in the

number of the regular admission in the local area is the largest(-4,907) with a small increase in both the early and the regular admissions of the college in the capital area.

b. The keynote identical to that in the previous year that the early admission is mainly based on the school record and the regular admission on the SAT result.

(1) Recruitment Ratio by Admission

According to the standardized college admission system focusing on the main factors, the early admission evaluation is based on the school record and the regular admission on the SAT.

- 233,479(85.8%) students out of 272,032(the total number of the early admission) are selected by the student record admission(academic, comprehensive).
- 66,300(91.7%) students out of 72,264(the total number of the regular admission) are selected by the SAT admission.

(2) Comparison between the ratios in the capital and the local area

- The capital area selects students in the order of SAT > Comprehensive > Academic > Practical test > Essay.
- The local area selects students in the order of Academic > Comprehensive > SAT > Practical test > Essay.
- According to the revised plan for the college admission and enhancing fairness, colleges in the capital area must select more than 30% of students by SAT admission, which is why the SAT admission has the biggest ratio.
- According to the revised plan for the college admission, colleges in the local area can choose either the SAT or the student record admission, and most of the school select more than 30% of the students by student record which has the biggest number of the students to be selected.

(3) Comparison between the early and the regular admissions in the capital and the local areas

- Compared to the last year, the academic record admission decreased in number by 536 in the capital area and increased by 193 in the local area.
- Compared to the last year, the comprehensive student record admission decreased in number by 520 in the capital area and decreased by 1,512 in the local area.
- The essay admission in the early admission is newly started by some colleges (Dongduk Women's University, Samyook University, Seokyeong University, etc.) and the number increased by 340 in the capital area compared to the last year.
- The number of the students in the SAT admission in the regular admission increased by 593 in the capital area and decreased by 4,204 in the local area.

c. Increase in the social integration, local talent admissions

(1) Increased number in the social integration(balanced opportunity, balanced regional admission) admission

- Due to the mandatory balanced regional admission according to the revised enforcement decree of the higher education act, the balanced opportunity admission increased to 36,434 students, 2,372 more than the previous year.
- The number of students to be selected by the balanced regional admission (principal recommendation based on academic reports) in the capital area recommended by the enforcement decree of the higher education act is 2,997 more than that in the previous year.

(2) The admission name and qualification changed into social integration

- Due to the enforcement decree of the higher education act from 2004, ‘the social integration admission’ includes patriots and veteran recipients, the disabled, the low income family, the rural area, specialized school graduates and workers, students in the 5 islands in Seohae(west sea), the youth after protection period, North Korean refugees, and those specified in the basic requirements for college admission(adult learners). Compared to the previous fair opportunity admission, the youth after protection period, North Korean refugees, and those studying late are included.

(3) Increased number of the local talent admission

- As the number of the recruitment in medical/dental/Korean medical/pharmacy/nursing colleges increased due to the revision of the enforcement decree of the regional university promotion act, the number of the local talent admission increased by 2,581 than the last year. The school that has the local talent admission increased by 10 schools, from 93 to 103 schools.

d. Applying SAT Minimum standard in the early admission

Most of the balanced region admission of colleges in the capital area takes the SAT minimum standard, and the medical schools in the local talent admission mostly takes the high SAT minimum standard.

The total number of students to which the SAT minimum standard is applied is 134,339, or 62,075 in the early admission and 72,264 in the regular admission, which is 39.02% of the total number of recruitment. It means, the early admission has a relatively low SAT minimum standard but SAT still has a large influence on the 2024 admission system.

The ratio of the application of SAT minimum standard is Essay > Academic record > Comprehensive record > Practical test.

5. Classification of admission

- a. There are admissions within and out of quota, and the out of quota is not included to the quota of a college.
- b. The recruitment within quota falls into two categories: general and special admissions, while the recruitment out of quota only has a special admission. The general admission recruits student based on a typical education standard, and the special admission based on a standard of a college such as special history, talent, etc. or graded approach. The special admission out of quota includes the balanced opportunity or social consideration, etc.

II 2024 Early Admission

1. Balanced region admission

- a. According to the fairness enhancing plan in 2022, According to the revised plan for the college admission and enhancing fairness, colleges in the capital area such as Seoul, Incheon and Gyeonggi have balanced region admission for balanced development in the local areas, which is based on academic records with a principal's recommendation.

The number of the colleges that has the balanced region admission in the capital area is 47. 31 colleges, which is 65.9% of the total number, are recruiting students based on academic records 100% while the others apply interviews and documentations, etc. as well as the academic records. Colleges in the capital area that do not have the balanced region admission are Seokyeong Univ., Yongin Univ., Pyeongtaek Univ., Hyupsung Univ., etc. Seoul National University and the medical school of the Catholic University of Korea, etc. are recruiting students based on the comprehensive school record in the balanced region admission. There is need of thorough review on the changes of the number of recruitment, SAT minimum standard, recommendation standard, etc. of many colleges.
- c. 29 colleges out of 47 colleges, which are 61.7% of the colleges that have the balanced region admission, are applying the SAT minimum standard. The number of the students for the principal's recommendation admission differs from college to college, but most of the colleges requires a certain number of students or a certain percentage of total students.
- d. Colleges that apply the SAT minimum standard with a restriction on the number of students to be recommended are: Korea Univ., Sogang Univ., Sungkyunkwan Univ., etc. Colleges that apply the SAT minimum standard without a restriction on the number of students to be recommended are: Catholic Univ. of Korea, Gacheon Univ., Kookmin Univ., Soongsil Univ., Ajou Univ., etc. Colleges that do not have the SAT minimum



standard are: Gacheon Univ., Konkuk Univ., Kwangwoon Univ., Dongguk Univ., Yonsei Univ., Ewha Womans Univ., Hanyang Univ., etc. There is a difference in the number of students to be recommended from that in 2023. The number increased to 20 from 10 at Sogang Univ., 8 from 10 at University of Seoul, and Sookmyung Women's University abolished the restriction on the number. Yonsei Univ. changed the number from 5% to up to 10 students from each school, while Hankuk University of Foreign Studies did not change the number, which is 20, but has a restriction on the number to be within 10 students for each campus, unlike 2023. Dongduk Women's Univ., Samyook Univ., Hansung Univ., Anyang Univ., TECH Univ. of Korea, Korea Aerospace Univ. have newly opened the principal's recommendation admission, and Seoul National Univ. of Education changed the admission from the comprehensive to the academic records admission.

As there are colleges that changed the recommendation standard, the number of students, methods, etc. compared to 2023 or newly established a new admission, there is a need of a thorough review over the admissions of each college.

- e. Compared to the balanced region admission in 2023, Kyonggi University abolished the SAT minimum standard. Korea University reduced the SAT standard for the humanity colleges which was different to that for the natural science department, and the standard became the same for both of the departments. Sogang Univ., Sungkyunkwan Univ., and Hanyang Univ.(ERICA) reduced the standard. Sungshin Women's Univ. and Inha Univ. reduced the SAT minimum standard while Hankuk University of Foreign Studies(Global) newly established the SAT minimum standard. For the colleges with a restriction on the number of recommended students, particularly, it is a competition among the students who have been recommended only and therefore the minimum standard can have a great influence on the final result. It is needed to consider an active strategy by fulfilling the minimum standard with well-preparation for SAT.

- f. Most of the colleges that have the balanced region admission apply the school record 100%, but some of them apply document screening and interviews as well. Konkuk Univ., Kyunghee Univ., Korea Univ., Dongguk Univ. etc. are applying the document screening. If Dongguk University considers the application of the records of top 10 subjects only, the influence of the document screening is expected to be huge. Yonsei University has an interview with a provided document that has a large influence on admission since there is no SAT minimum standard. Seoul National University of Education, Gacheon University and University of Suwon also have an interview and therefore those who wish to apply for either of the schools shall be prepared for the interview by giving presentations in their class, etc. and are recommended to look up 'the report of the result of advanced learning' of each school.
- g. Colleges that accept current students(to graduate in 2024) only for the recommendation admission are: Kyunghee Univ., Korea Univ., Sogang Univ., Seoul National Univ. of Education, Sungkyunkwan Univ., Yonsei Univ., etc. The other colleges accept students up to a certain year of graduation, and Hankuk University of Foreign Studies has largely reduced the applicant's qualification down to the 2023 graduates.
- h. The result of 2023 balanced region admission shows a high competition rate in overall despite the little difference among departments. Additional recruitment rate is high due to the multiple recommendation and acceptance, but the admission result is fairly high as well. Those who wish to apply for the balanced region admission must pay good attention to get high academic records consistently. It is desirable to work on the SAT as well since there are colleges that apply the SAT minimum standard. It is needed to check any change in the balanced region admission for each school through a school consultation about the final admission result in 2022 and 2023 at the moment of actual application.

2. How to prepare for school records

a. The academic records are mandatory.

The school records admission that applies school records for more than 50% could include an interview or other admission, however, the most fundamental factor is academic records. Colleges have different standards about the academic records, however, it is mandatory to work hard on getting high records.

b. You must be prepared for SAT to fulfill the minimum standard.

The academic record admission has a relatively high minimum standard compared to the other admissions. Though different from college to college, the minimum standard fulfillment rate is about 50% which means it is one of the biggest factors to be considered for students applying for the academic admission. Due to the characteristics of the academic record admission, most of the applicant make a stable decision,



however, whether to fulfil the minimum standard or not can be a core factor to apply for a higher college in consideration of the balanced region admission of colleges in the capital area. Therefore, a student must be fully prepared for SAT.

c. You must consider application by the converted point of each college.

Each college has different methods of academic records calculation, which depend on the subject range, the number of subjects, calculation index(rank, raw score, achievement, etc.), percentage by grade, by subject, or whether to include a career-selective subject or not. Most of the humanity colleges include Korean, Math, English and social studies while the science colleges include Korean, Math, English and science. For the purpose of the revised curriculum in 2015, however, there are quite a number of colleges that include Korean, math, English, social studies, science and Korean history, and some colleges even include all subjects. It is important to check which combination of subjects is advantageous to you. You also need to be prepared by complete understanding of plans and admissions of each college as the preparation process could be differ for everyone. Rather than applying for a school only based on great academic grades, you must determine whether your application is appropriate or not based on the converted point for each college. Using a grade table of the converted point for each college can be useful.

d. You must be fully prepared for interviews and document screening depending on the admission category.

It's not rare for interviews, document screening and others to be included in the academic record admission. Particularly for graded admission, interviews, document screening and others often change the final result in the second phase, and therefore it is needed to make up for a disadvantage of your grades by preparing for interviews, document screening, etc.

Even you are considering the academic record admission only, you also need to prepare for interviews and document screening focusing on your class and mock interviews at school. It can be helpful as well to analyze examples of the initial acceptance, additional acceptance and failure to compare the actual assessment function of document screening or interviews to set your strategy.

e. Set your goal referring to the result of the previous year.

All colleges open the information about the previous year's admission result on their admission website as well as 'the admission information portal adiga.' You need to prepare for the academic record admission with the admission result. However, you are recommended to review the result for the recent 3 years instead of the result in the previous year only. Approach to the result analysis considering multiple factors such as the admission category, changes in the factors, changes of the SAT minium standard, etc., quota, integration or division of department/college, etc. Keep in mind that these examples can help you check the actual influence of interviews, etc. on the final acceptance.

3. Characteristics of the comprehensive record admission in 2024

- a. Divided by period and region, the number of recruitment of the comprehensive record admission in the capital area is 38,787, which is 45.5% of the total number in the early admission, but it is 42,603 in the local area which is 22.8%. The percentage of the comprehensive record admission is higher in the capital area than that in the local area, and the difference in the regular admission is not significant.

- b. On the basis of 2024 SAT admission plan, 148 colleges out of 216 colleges are having the comprehensive admission. In Seoul, 34 colleges have the comprehensive admission except for these 8 colleges: Methodist Theological University, Gangseo University, Seokyeong University, Seoul Christian University, Seoul Hanyoung University, Chugye University for the Arts, Korean Bible University, Korea National Sport University. In Busan, 14 colleges have the comprehensive admission except Inje University.
- c. Due to the enhanced fairness plan for college admission announced in 2019, a cover letter was one of the factors needed for the admission till 2023, but the letter is abolished in 2024. The document screening deals with the school record instead of the cover letter. Therefore the school record has become a lot more important in the comprehensive record admission.
- d. Starting in 2024 admission, award records, autonomous club activity, individual volunteering and book reading records are not included in the school record, making academic achievement and activities more important. Regular club activities, in-school volunteering are included so that earnest participation in the school life became more significant. Book reading records are not included in the admission, but reading activities can be recorded qualitatively during the class or creative experience activity in the school record. In other words, the book reading itself is not completely removed from the admission although the record is not directly evaluated. Therefore, it's more reasonable to think that the method of evaluation has changed for book reading.
- e. Some colleges have multiple comprehensive record admissions, and the following colleges are having two different categories of the comprehensive record admission in 2024: interview and document screening.

Admission for students from multicultural family

1. Colleges a student from multicultural family can apply for

a. The list and characteristics of the multicultural family early admission in 2024

- (1) The special balanced opportunity admission must be conducted to provide an equal opportunity to receive advanced education for everyone, however, the multicultural family admission is to be operated upon a college's own decision.
- (2) The multicultural family admission selects students only within the quota of the integrated social admission, and the qualification and the exact number of recruitment is determined upon a college's own decision without a certain enforcement.

- b. In the early admission 2024, the number of 4-year colleges that have the multicultural family admission is 66 in total, including 12 in Seoul and 8 in Busan. Dongyang University is the only college that newly established the admission in 2024, and Yongsan University, Seoul National University of Education, International University of Korea, Sangji University, University of Suwon, Pyeongtaek University, Hankyong National University, Mokpo National University, Jeju International University, FarEast University, etc. abolished the admission.
- c. All colleges in Korea selects students based on the school records within the quota.
- d. The multicultural admission has various names: multicultural(family students), social consideration (recipient), social contributor, balanced opportunity, social integration, equal opportunity, etc.
- e. The colleges that gives qualification only to the students from multicultural family are: Gwangju National University of Education, Busan University of Foreign Studies, Jeonju National University of Education, Jinju National University of Education(including North Korean refugees), Cheongju National University of Education, Chuncheon National University of Education.
- f. The number of recruitment per admission is 1 or 2, which is very small, and the competition rate is lower than non-special admissions.

2. Multicultural family admissions and methods

- a. The admissions evaluate the student record, document screening and interviews.
- b. Most of the academic record admissions evaluate the academic record 100%, however, Kangwon National University has document screening, and Methodist Theological University, Acts University, Hanseo University, etc. have an interview. For the comprehensive admission, there are colleges that have a document screening 100% and those that have a staged admission by selecting a certain times more students in stage 1 then have an interview. Konkuk University and Kyunghee University evaluate the school record 30%, reflecting the academic records quantitatively.
- c. Some of the colleges that have a staged admission, including Gwangju National University of Education, Pusan National University of Education, University of Seoul, Seoul theological University, Sunchon National University, Yonsei University, Jeonbuk National University, Jeonju National University of Education, Cheongju National University of Education, Handong University, etc. selects 2.5-5 times more students in stage 1 with the document screening 100% and have a final selection with the sum of stage 1 record and an interview in stage 2.
- d. For the academic record admission which a student from multicultural family can apply for, there is no college that applies the SAT minimum standard. For the

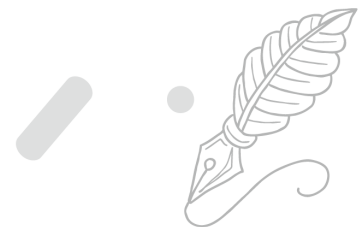
